



# St. Michael's Proposed Sport Premium Spending 2023-24

In the 2023/24 academic year we expect to receive £16,920. The money will be spent to fulfil the following grant conditions:

1. The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity.
2. The profile of PE and sport raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement.
3. Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport.
4. Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils.
5. Increasing participation in competitive sport.

Competition SLA from Sedgefield Sports Partnership (SSP)	To provide opportunities for all children to access competitive sports. Throughout the year, every child will attend either a competition or festival where they will compete against other children from local schools. This will increase their participation in competitive sports and provide a range of sports and activities that children can take part in. Competitions include: cross country events, tag rugby, football, basketball, OAA, cricket, netball and many more.	4, 5	£2000.00

Transport	Hired busses to transport pupils to and from competitions/festivals throughout the academic year.	5	£3,000 (Estimate)
Fit 4 Life Licence	To increase the amount of daily exercise, all children will participate in Fit for Life sessions throughout the week to increase their physical and mental health whilst improving personal development and cognitive function.	1, 2, 3, 4, 5	£475.75
Move More Daily (Go Well)	To increase both physical activity and lifelong mental wellbeing through the Team Up Kids programme. This will support children in developing techniques to maintain good wellbeing and provide opportunity for children to learn how to work with their natural brain chemicals to be successful.	1, 2	£346.00
Team Up (Go Well)	To provide whole school staff with CPD opportunities to understand the importance of daily activity, elevating our current daily physical activity offer. This in turn will raise the profile of physical activity within school and increase the knowledge and confidence among staff.	1, 2, 3	£1,340.00

Equipment	Equipment is needing to be purchased to ensure that an engaging curriculum can be continually delivered. Due to the amount certain equipment is used, regular updates are required. Examples include - footballs, soft balls, bean bags, tennis balls, tennis rackets, medals to award achievements etc.	1, 4	£2,000 (Estimate)
Archery Tag	To engage pupils and raise the profile of physical activity, archery tag will be provided at break times and lunch times, alongside an afterschool club. This will also enable children to broaden their experiences in a range of different and competitive sports.	1, 4	£2,000.00
Active Travel Tracker	To encourage children to actively travel, the active travel tracker will allow children to log how they travel to school and badges will be awarded throughout the academic year. This will help to engage children in regular physical activity.	1	£300.00
Moki Health Fitness Tracker	Moki fitness trackers will allow children to take ownership of their own health data and encourage them to lead active lives. This will support the engagement and participation in regular activity for pupils.	1, 2, 4, 5	£1,500.00 (estimate)

National School Sport Week	To raise the profile of physical activity, children will participate in a range of sports throughout the week that they may not have the opportunity to outside of school. The money spent will allow children to engage with such experiences such as trampolining, mountain biking etc.	2, 4	£1,000.00
Street Games Activity Day	Children will complete a session learning new games to encourage increased participation in physical activity outside of school. Following on from COVID, it has been a priority to encourage children to be more active in school and we want to continue to provide children with the tools to do this outside of school.	1, 2, 4	£240.00
AE Coaching	To continue to provide children with a broad range of sporting experiences, we will be working closely with AE Coaching who will deliver a range of afterschool clubs. Children who have limited participation in sport and physical activity will be invited to try to increase their participation levels in sports and activities that they may not be familiar with.	1, 2, 4	£500.00

Healthy Schools	The self-audit tool will help to monitor physical activity and the health and wellbeing of the children in school. From this we can identify action point to address to continually improve.	2	£250.00
